#### 25 Trainer Competencies in 5 main areas:

- 1. Adult and Experiential Learning
- 2. Training Delivery and Facilitation
- 3. Professionalism and Ethics
- 4. Equity and Diversity
- 5. Co-Training



# Example of a competency within Adult and Experiential Learning:

- "Trainer understands and caters to different adult learning styles"
  - Auditory
  - Kinesthetic
  - Visual
- This may look like: writing instructions on flip-chart paper, having participants do a gallery walk, pair share, or writing down answers to a reflection question.



Trainers will learn and practice the Trainer Competencies throughout the certification process:

- Completing the Self-assessment
- Attending the ToT
- Completing 16 hours of training in the field
- Support of CalSAC Mentor and Cohort Meetings
- Mentor observation



#### **Trainer Self-Assessment:**

- First introduction to Trainer Competencies
- To be completed prior to the ToT
- Results will be shared with Mentor
- An opportunity for reflection on past training facilitation, training strengths, and areas of growth



- Deliver 16 hours of training to field (for own organization and/or external agencies in the community) from the list of 20 Apprentice Trainer module topics
- Virtual Cohort Meetings
- In-person Observation by a CalSAC Mentor
- Deadline: July, 2024\*
